

The meeting was called to order at 10:am by Ginny Stone. The purpose of the meeting was for Commission to review the slide presentation which had been prepared by the MSCA Restoration Committee for presentation during the Potluck Supper later that evening. Ginny Stone presented an outline of the program and members unanimously approved it as presented.

There were informal discussions about the manner and cost of the proposed foundation work, the replacement of windows, repair of the copula and possible strengthening of the supports beneath it at the roofline.

The overall tenor of the meeting was positive, with both groups expressing an intention to cooperate and communicate more closely in the future, with a common aim of completing restoration of the Community Hall in a manner consistent with Secretary of Interior Standards. All agreed that this project will be the most important and significant undertaking of the Historic Preservation Commission since the establishment of the Historic District itself; and a project that is vital to the community as a whole, since the Community Hall is the most significant structure in our town.

The meeting closed with a prayer led by Burt Hinson at 11:03am.
