

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-07

Adopting a Moratorium on the Vacation of Streets or Alleys

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama is reviewing the processes and procedures for considering petitions requesting the vacation of streets or alleys; and


WHEREAS, the Council believes said processes and procedures will require revision in order to carry into effect or discharge the powers and duties conferred by Alabama law, and to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity and improve the morals, order, comfort, and convenience of the inhabitants of Magnolia Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes it will not be in the Town's best interest to consider petitions requesting the vacation of streets or alleys within the Town for a period of sixty (60) days in order to give the Council sufficient time to review and revise said processes and procedures;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama, that a moratorium be placed on the vacation of streets or alleys within the jurisdiction of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama, for a period of sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Resolution, to allow the Council sufficient time to review and revise its processes and procedures for considering petitions requesting the vacation of streets or alleys.

THEREFORE, Dotty Johnson, a Councilmember, made the motion and Bob Holk, a Council member, seconded the motion that said resolution be approved and said resolution passed by majority vote of the Council, and the Mayor declared the Resolution so passed.
