

Fire Prevention Week 2024 Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Springs is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our Town; and

WHEREAS, fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk from fire; and

WHEREAS, home fires caused 2,580 civilian deaths in the United States in 2020, according to the National Fire Protection Association® (NFPA®), and fire departments in the United States responded to 356,500 home fires; and

WHEREAS, smoke alarms sense smoke well before you can, alerting you to danger in the event of fire in which you may have as little as 2 minutes to escape safely; and

WHEREAS, working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home fires in half; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Springs residents should be sure everyone in the home understands the sounds of the smoke alarms and knows how to respond; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Springs residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Springs residents will make sure their smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarms meet the needs of all their family members, including those with sensory or physical disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Magnolia Springs Volunteer Fire Department is dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia Springs residents that are responsive to public education measures are better able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes.

Now THEREFORE, I, Ross Houser, Mayor of Magnolia Springs Alabama, do hereby proclaim October 6-12, 2024, as
